We bid farewell to Mr Murray Spence at the end of this term. Mr Spence has been a valued member of Selborne College since 2017, serving as Head of Cricket and MIC of Sport, and has given dedicated service to his alma mater. We thank him for his commitment and contribution to the College and wish him every success in his future endeavours.

**ACADEMICS**

Once again, Selborne College is proud to be recognised as a Top Achieving School in our District, with several staff receiving certificates for a 100% pass rate in their respective subjects in the 2025 NSC Examinations.

We congratulate Brett Tyler, who won the jointly awarded Top Information Technology Trophy in the Buffalo City District for the 2025 NSC Matric Examinations, achieving an outstanding 97%. The Class of 2025 achieved a 99% pass rate, with multiple learners receiving the following distinctions:

6 Distinctions	-	2 Candidates

We hosted two important Parent–Teacher Meetings for Grades 11 and 12, providing an opportunity to engage with parents, discuss academic progress, set goals, and share strategies for success, reinforcing the partnership between school and home in guiding our boys toward excellence.

Term 1 has been demanding, yet our academic programme has remained steadfast in its pursuit of excellence. Our Grade 12 class achieved a 93% Bachelor pass rate, with 48% earning a place on the Merit List (70% aggregate and above). We trust they will use this positive start as motivation to maintain, and where possible improve, their performance as the year progresses.

Staff have continued to implement innovative, practical teaching approaches aimed at encouraging learners to think creatively and engage beyond conventional boundaries.

**CULTURE**

Cultural Week was a highlight of Term 1. Events began on Friday, 13 March 2026, with the Bruce Gardiner Concert (featuring Lloy Brent and Friends) and was enjoyed by the wider community.

The Guitar Evening was a memorable occasion in a beautiful outdoor setting. Our talented learners, joined by educators and Old Selbornians, captivated an enthusiastic audience of parents, staff, learners, and Old Boys. The atmosphere was filled with nostalgia and a shared appreciation for live music, celebrating Selbornian talent past and present.

The Interhouse Plays and Street Art Competition were won by Perry House.

The IsiXhosa Evening was a wonderful celebration of community, culture, and giving back. Learners and staff came together to showcase hours of dedicated practice, bringing traditional music and dance to life on stage. The event was also a feast, with delicious homemade food prepared by the society, adding warmth and flavour to the evening. Beyond entertainment, the evening had a meaningful purpose as the funds raised will be donated to support those in need, demonstrating the Selborne spirit of compassion and service.
